DEACON’S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This past Tuesday Candie and I met with the architects working on the Mission to get an update on upcoming projects. Work continues on reinforcing the bell tower area with the bell itself being restored and soon to be returned for our use.

We were originally told that work would begin in July on reinforcing the dome area above our sanctuary and that scaffolding would need to be set up inside the sanctuary area. It now appears that work on the dome will begin on the outside of the church and that if inside work is needed, it most likely will be put off until early 2020, after the Advent and Christmas seasons. Originally no weddings were scheduled until mid-November when we were initially told that the project would be completed. It now appears we may have to hold off on scheduling any weddings through May or June of next year.
